The Oglesby Union HISTORY

Organized in 1946 as a "community center" for students attending Florida State College for Women and the Tallahassee Branch of the University of Florida, the original Student Union operated as the "O" Club (The Officers' Club) at an abandoned air base, Dale Mabry Field. The "O" Club housed the Union until the mid-1950's when it was moved to its current location at Woodward Avenue and Tennessee Street. Extensive additions in 1964 enlarged the complex and in August 1988 a renovation and expansion project was completed.

The Roscoe R. Oglesby Union Complex was named for Dean Ross Oglesby, who had been an FSU Professor of Government for 19 years, serving concurrently for 10 years as Dean of Students. Buildings in the Complex are named for distinguished graduates: Robert Edward Crenshaw, Helen Morris Davis, and Coyle E. Moore, Jr. The formal dining room in the Union was named for Holata Micco, a Seminole Indian Chief, and the Senate Chamber was named for Robert A. Brandewie, an advisor to the Student Government Association.



The Oglesby Union

The Oglesby Union is a diverse and engaging community that fosters individual and collective learning by providing outstanding services and opportunities for involvement for students.

The union is the community center of the university, serving students, faculty, staff, alumni and guests. By whatever form or name, a college union is an organization offering a variety of programs, activities, services and facilities that, when taken together, represent a well-considered plan for the community life of the university.

The union serves as a unifying force that honors each individual and values diversity. The union fosters a sense of community that cultivates enduring loyalty to the university.

Traditionally considered the "hearthstone" or "living room" of the campus, today's union is the gathering place of the university. The union provides services and conveniences that members of the college community need in their daily lives and creates an environment for getting to know and understand others through formal and informal associations.

The Oglesby Union is an integral part of the educational program of the Florida State University, providing students with cultural, social, educational, and recreational programs. It serves as a laboratory of citizenship; training students in social responsibilities and leadership. Oglesby Union facilities shall act as a central gathering place for the university community. The University Community is defined as any current student, faculty and staff member, alumni or guest.



OGLESBY UNION FLOOR PLANS




First Floor
